

Thousands of hourly employees in the restaurant business have been abruptly laid off and are struggling. Jewish Family Service partnered with several generous donors to establish the S.H.E.F. Emergency Assistance Fund. The S.H.E.F. Fund is an effort to provide "bridge" support to as many restaurant hourly workers as possible throughout Dallas. In addition to this financial support, JFS will be providing case management assistance and connecting workers to eligible benefits, employment opportunities, counseling and other resources as they navigate this ongoing crisis. Applicants will be provided between \$500 and \$1,000 depending on their circumstance.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Call the Jewish Family Service intake line (972) 437-9950 x340
- 2. Leave a message with information and needs
- 3. Have proof of identification and last pay stub easily accessible

WHAT TO EXPECT

- 1. A call back within 1-3 business days
- 2. Needs Assessment completed with a JFS staff member
- 3. Copy of ID, Last Paystub, Notice of Furlough/Layoff, and a Utility or Rental Bill may be requested
- 4. If approved, check will be mailed within 1 week from approval date
